²² I hate them with perfect hatred; I count them my enemies.


²³ Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties;

²⁴ And see if *there is any* wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.


MISSIONARY CORNER Each week we focus on Missionaries and Organizations we support as a local church.
