Psalm 147 Praise to God for His Word and Providence ¹Praise the LORD! For *it is* good to sing praises to our God; For *it is* pleasant, *and* praise is beautiful. ² The LORD builds up Jerusalem; He gathers together the outcasts of Israel. ³He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. ⁴He counts the number of the stars; He calls them all by name. ⁵ Great *is* our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding *is* infinite. ⁶ The LORD lifts up the humble; He casts the wicked down to the ground. ⁷ Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving; Sing praises on the harp to our God, ⁸ Who covers the heavens with clouds, who prepares rain for the earth, Who makes grass to grow on the mountains. ⁹He gives to the beast its food, and to the young ravens that cry. ¹⁰ He does not delight in the strength of the horse; He takes no pleasure in the legs of a man. ¹¹ The LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him, In those who hope in His mercy. ¹² Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem! Praise your God, O Zion! ¹³ For He has strengthened the bars of your gates; He has blessed your children within you. ¹⁴He makes peace *in* your borders, and fills you with the finest wheat. ¹⁵ He sends out His command *to the* earth; His word runs very swiftly. ¹⁶He gives snow like wool; He scatters the frost like ashes; ¹⁷ He casts out His hail like morsels; Who can stand before His cold? ¹⁸He sends out His word and melts them; He causes His wind to blow, and the waters flow. ¹⁹He declares His word to Jacob, His statutes and His judgments to Israel. ²⁰ He has not dealt thus with any nation; And as for His judgments,

MEMORIZING THE ROMANS ROAD

The Book of Romans provides these verses that teach us: 1.Who needs salvation, 2.Why we need salvation, 3. How God provides salvation, and 4.How we receive salvation. Memorizing these verses will enable you to give God's plan of salvation to those whom you meet:

1. Romans 3:10 As it is written: There is none righteous, no, not one.

2. Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

3. Romans 5:8 But God shows His love for us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

4. Romans 5:12 Therefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."
