⁴⁵ **The foreigners fade away, and come frightened from their hideouts.**

⁴⁶ The Lord lives! Blessed *be* my Rock!

Let the God of my salvation be exalted.

⁴⁷ ***It is* God who avenges me, and subdues the peoples under me;**

⁴⁸ He delivers me from my enemies. You also lift me up above those who rise against me; You have delivered me from the violent man.

⁴⁹ **Therefore I will give thanks to You, O Lord, among the Gentiles,**

And sing praises to Your name.

⁵⁰ **Great deliverance He gives to His king, and shows mercy to His anointed, to David and his descendants forevermore.**

The story of Word of Life starts with the vision of Jack Wyrzten, who believed, “It is the responsibility of every generation to reach their generation for Christ.” Jack founded Word of Life Fellowship in 1940 as an outgrowth of a Bible study.
