


A COMPARISON BETWEEN DANIEL'S FOURTH BEAST
AND THE BEAST OF REVELATION

The Image of Daniel 2



Daniel's Fourth Beast:

Comes up out of the sea
(7:3)

606 ± B.C.
Gold – Nebuchadnezzar's Babylon (Unquestioned obedience to one absolute sovereign)

Ten horns—ten kings
(7:7, 24)

Another horn (Antichrist) becomes dominant ruler
(7:24-26)

536 ± B.C.
Silver – The dual Empire of the Medes & Persians (The 2 arms!)

Stamped with the feet
(7:7)

Great iron teeth
(7:7)

336 B.C.
Copper – The Greek Empire

200 ± B.C.
Iron Legs 'United' – Roman Republic & Empire

300 ± A.D.
Iron Legs Divided – Western & Eastern Roman Empire

476 & 1453 A.D. (They fall)

Iron Legs Cracking – European States

Iron & Clay Feet – End-time Lawlessness (Communism)?
10 Toes – Revived Rome Confederacy
A.D.?

Revelation's Beast:

Comes up out of the sea
(13:1)

Seven heads (13:1)
Ten horns—ten kings
(13:1; 17:12)

The beast as a person (cf. 19:20) becomes dominant ruler
(17:12-13)

Like a leopard (13:2)
Feet of a bear (13:2)
Mouth of a lion (13:2)
(Dan. 7:4-6).

This beast has characteristics from each of Daniel's first three beasts,
viz., lion, bear & leopard
(Dan. 7:4-6).

Scarlet color (17:3)
blasphemous (13:5)
Dragon gives him power (13:2)
Persecutes saints (13:7; 11:7)
Power for 42 months (3 1/2 years)
(13:5)

Defeated by God who then sets up the Kingdom (19:11–20:6)
